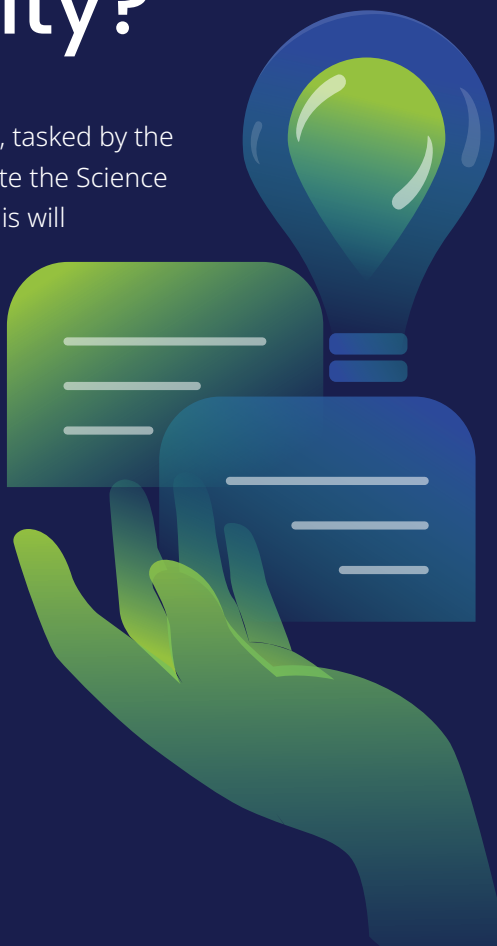




What are BioAgora and the Science Service for Biodiversity?

BioAgora is an EU-funded project, tasked by the European Commission to co-create the Science Service for Biodiversity (SSBD). This will be the scientific pillar of the **EU Knowledge Centre for Biodiversity** – a central knowledge hub for biodiversity-related policy-making. It connects researchers, experts, practitioners and citizen science professionals with EU institutions through structured knowledge co-creation mechanisms.



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How to engage with the Science Service

1 CONTRIBUTE TO KNOWLEDGE REQUESTS

The SSBD coordinates expert input and facilitates the co-creation of responses to knowledge requests from policymakers. The SSBD needs the input of many experts. Here's how you can get involved:

a. Content contributions

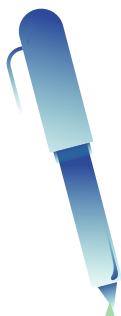
- submit expertise and practical experience to open calls for knowledge.
- suggest policy-relevant questions and discuss them with policy officers
- act as expert for, or reviewer of, knowledge outputs

b. Process contributions

- organise or support events linked to a knowledge request
- host capacity development events
- organise activities that align with the objectives of relevant EU project clusters
- act as a facilitator (focal point) of a knowledge request

EXAMPLE IN PRACTICE

BioAgora mobilised experts to co-develop a knowledge response on **Urban Greening Tools**, to help implement the Nature Restoration Regulation.



2 PARTICIPATE IN OR CO-ORGANISE EVENTS WITH BIOAGORA

Join events organised by BioAgora and participate in dialogues on relevant topics, to align your work with legislative and strategic processes.

3 JOIN POLICY-ORIENTED KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE NETWORKS

Connect to one or more topical **Knowledge Exchange Networks** according to your interests and expertise. These act as knowledge hubs to feed into biodiversity policy processes.

4 ENGAGE WITH THE BROADER BIOAGORA COMMUNITY

Join the **Biodiversity Knowledge Agora** – a broad network of experts and stakeholders underpinning the SSBD.

5 SHARE YOUR EXPERTISE AND COLLABORATE

For strong policy impact, co-organise communication actions with BioAgora. Or join the BioAgora **Communications Hub**, a space for aligning outreach strategies across biodiversity-focused initiatives.

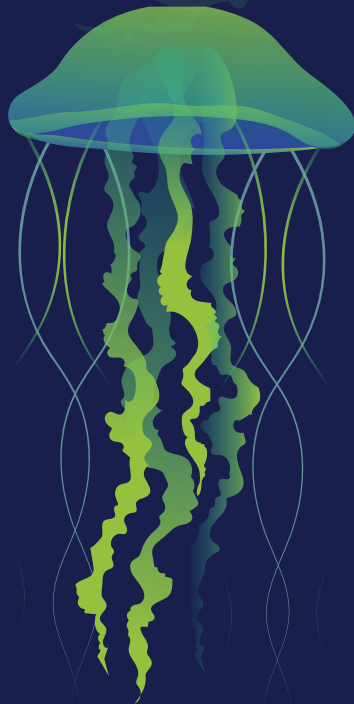
This is not just an opportunity – it is a responsibility for all stakeholders to engage meaningfully, plan for policy impact and help shape a more sustainable future for Europe.
