BioAgora main functions

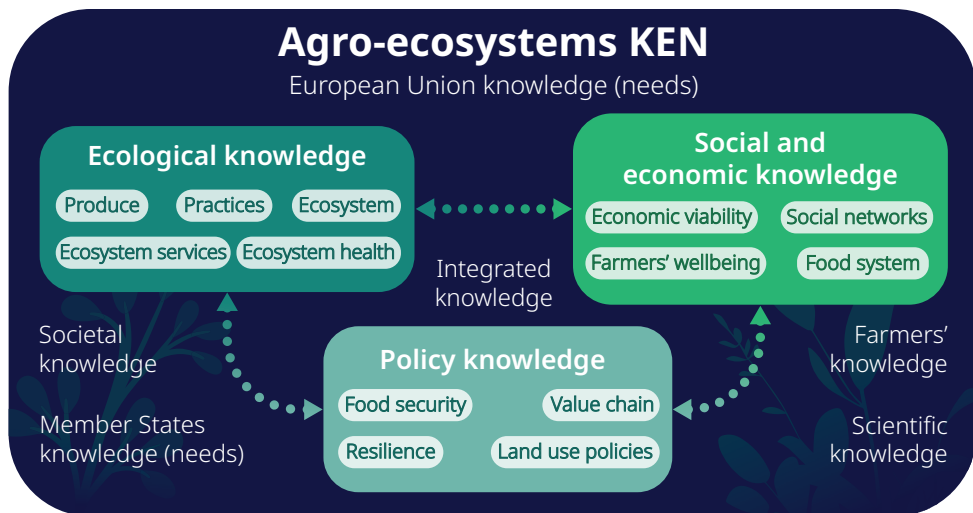


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The Agroecosystems KEN:

- Participates in knowledge requests from the European Commission
- Enhances collaboration among key institutions, EU funded projects and their experts, European knowledge networks on e.g. agroecosystems, agroecology, organic farming, regenerative agriculture
- Works closely with IPBES, IUCN, the EU Agroecology Partnership, Network Nature and other relevant networks
- Advances knowledge exchange, capacity, and dialogue on restoring agro-ecosystems, including the socio-ecological systems underlying agricultural production, and exploring pathways towards transforming the food system
- Optimises full use of scientific results and addresses science-policy implementation gaps regarding EU policies, including the Common Agriculture Policy, the EU Biodiversity Strategy 2030, the Farm to Fork Strategy, the Nature Restoration Regulation and the Habitats and Birds Directives
